2. Manchuria

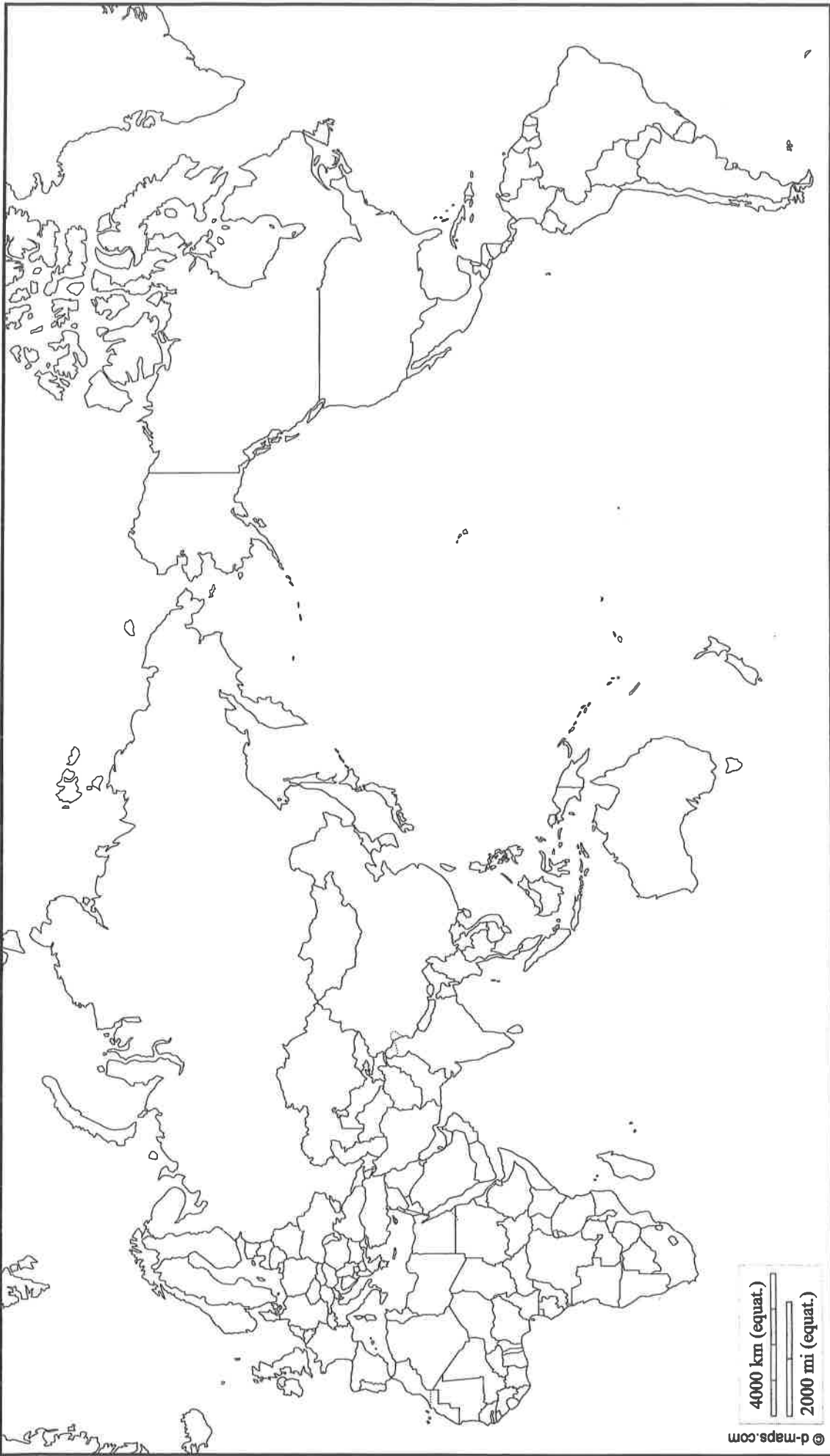
